2nd International Member Forum (online)

The 1st Forum was devoted to the question: What is the current situation of the General Anthroposophical Society and what are the burning issues for Anthroposophy or the Anthroposophical Society in the different countries and in our present time?

The participants of the first Forum made a prioritization of 15 issues that were brought up in the Forum. The most prioritized was about disconnection with the following sub-issues:

Disconnection:

- a. Between the Anthroposophical Society and the Anthroposophical Movement
- b. Between the young and old generations
- c. Between members and those who lead the society
- d. From the original source, the Anthroposophical impulse
- e. From the original intention for the Anthroposophical Society in the Christmas Conference
- f. Between inner and outer work
- g. Between theory, knowledge and practice
- h. Between the initiatives
- i. Through a lack of interest for each other
- j. Between individuals and institutions

In our next Forum on **March 16th, 2025** we want to go one step further and address the issue of disconnection including all sub-issues:

- Which tasks arise for us from this assessment of the current situation with regard to the issue of disconnection at all those levels, for Anthroposophy and the Anthroposophical Society as a whole and in the different countries?
- How can we engage towards a positive development in relation to this issue?

Being so close to the 100th anniversary of the death of Rudolf Steiner, we want to devote the coming International Members Forum on March 16th, 2025, to him.

If one looks to the individuality of Rudolf Steiner, his biography, his work and all he brought to the world as Anthroposophy, one can find that it is just the opposite of disconnection. In all his work, in the goals he pursued, there is always an impulse of bringing together what now in many areas, we find in a state of disconnectedness. Rudolf Steiner's life and work is a mastery of integrating and bringing together even that which one can hardly imagine could be brought together.

- One goal of the coming forum is to develop ideas about what we can do or how to come into concrete actions.
- Another goal is to help build communication bridges internationally between members who are willing to exchange and to commit themselves to working on these issues.
